Ofsted Inspection



On the 13th and 14th of July the school were inspected by Ofsted. The two day inspection looked at all areas within school from pupil outcomes, the quality of teaching, the personal welfare and behaviour of pupils and how the school works to keep children safe. As the final report has not been published, we are not allowed to inform parents about the overall judgment, but we are confident our pupils, parents and wider school community will be pleased that the inspectors identified how much progress the school had made over the past three years.

The inspection team commented on the excellent behaviour and learning attitudes of our pupils and how, in the final week of term, they were working hard and producing work of a high standard. This positive attitude from pupils was also shown in the number of pupils who responded the Ofsted to pupil questionnaire. Over 50 pupils responded, the highest number this inspection team had seen. This was also supported by the results from the Parentview questionnaire, where over 40 parents responded.

The final Ofsted report is expected to be published in 10 days after various checks and quality reviews have taken place. As soon as the report is published it will be shared with parents. Tuesday 19th July
