## Family Assemblies

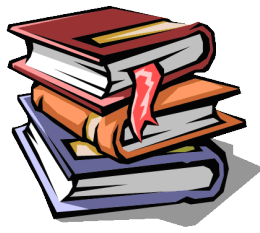
