



Sun Protection



What a year we have had so far with the weather. Initially we had wet weather and more snow than we could handle, now we are having the hottest May weather since records began.

To help keep your children safe from the sun in school, please can you ensure that they have sun cream, a hat and a bottle of water to keep them protected.

During the school day pupils have a morning break which lasts 15 minutes from 10:30am – 10:45am and an hour for lunch from 12:15pm – 1:15pm. Although the lunch break is broken up with children having a meal, they can still be outside for around 40 minutes. Please ensure that children have sun protection on them before they come to school so that any opportunity to enjoy the good weather is not dampened by the risk of getting sun burnt.

Car Parking

Please can parents avoid parking on the yellow zig zagged lines outside school as this can cause a hazard for people crossing the road and please be considerate when parking outside the homes of our neighbours at school drop off or home time.

Also, if parents do need to come into the school car park to drop children off, please ensure that speed is kept to a minimum as the car park is often congested with cars or with staff entering school.
