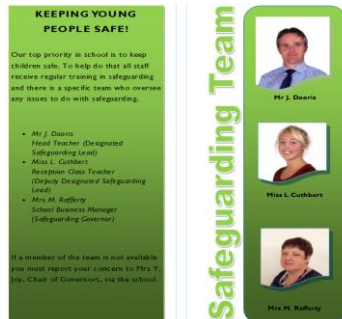


## Safeguarding
