

## Parent Lite App



As a school we have a duty to ensure that we look after your data and take all necessary steps to check that this data is up to date. To help us do that we are planning to use an App called Sims Parent Lite which will allow parents to make sure that the data we hold about them is accurate and up to date. As well as being able to check that the data we have about you and your child/children is accurate, you will also be able to stay up to date about school dates and to be notified about school events.

Over the next two weeks there will be more information about how you can check your data, but a good first step would be to download the app in preparation for this. The app can be downloaded from the Apple and Android store and is called 'Sims Parent'.
