## School Meal Changes



During this week we have launched our new dinner time routine in school. The aim of the routine is to provide a much better dinner experience for our pupils, provide more quality time for them to eat a full meal and provide a much better range of activities for pupils outside. So far the trial has gone well, although we still need to work on the time it is taking our younger pupils to move through the dinner service. One thing that is working really well is the good quality play outside, while one half of the school are eating inside.

As well as the improvements to school meals we are also looking at improving the quality of packed lunches. With that in mind, we have introduced a new '*Water for All*' policy, where all pupils can have access to school water. This will reduce the risk to pupils from drinking sugary drinks.

Hopefully, you have heard from your children how the changes are going. We are continually assessing the impact of our changes and know that with a few more subtle changes, these changes will really make a big difference to lunchtime in school.
