Disco – Thursday 11th July

Reception to Year 2 pupils: 3:30pm – 4:30pm.

Parents do not need to attend. Pupils will be taken to the disco, if attending, by their class teacher. Please can pupils be collected from the key stage 1 playground at 4:30pm.

Prom

The year 6 prom will take place at 5:30pm on Thursday the 11th of July. From 6:30pm, there will be a disco where year 6 pupils will be joined by key stage 2 pupils. The disco will finish at 8:30pm.

Transition

Pupils will move into their new classes on Monday the 15th of July and will work with their new teacher until we break up on Friday the 19th of July. Our transition week has always been a positive way to introduce pupils to the year group they will be working in next year and has helped the start of the new academic year to progress smoothly.

All pupils will be informed about where their class is and where they line up in the playground before Monday. Pupils will line up in their existing class on Monday morning and will be taken to their new classroom by their class teacher.

Year 6 pupils attending Outwood Bydales will also go to their new school on this date. Pupils attending other secondary schools will be told about their transition individually. Pupils have to arrive at Bydales by 8:20am. Parents can transport pupils to school if necessary. Alternatively, there is a bus that leaves from the Top Shops at 7:45am at a cost of 80p. At the end of the school day, the bus will also drop them off here. To support the pupils during their transition week, there will be a member of staff at the bus stop and present at Outwood Bydales.

Dinner Money/Breakfast Club Fees/Robinwood

All dinner money and breakfast club fees for the final week of term must be paid to ParentMail by Friday 12th July. If there is not enough credit on your child's account for the final week you will be asked to supply them with a packed lunch for the week. All refunds due will be given in the final week of term.

If your child is changing meal options in September please let the school office know before July 18th.

The final instalment for Robinwood should also be paid by 12th July.

Reports

End of year reports will be sent out on Thursday the 11th of July. The Sats results, if applicable, will be included in the reports. The report will contain the annual written report from your child's class teacher, the attainment, progress and attendance report and if children are in reception, year 1, year 2 or year 6, the statutory assessment summary sheet which indicates how your child did with their end of year key stage, or phonics test.
