School Entry Times



School starts in class at 8:45am

The first bell will go at 8:43am when children are expected to line up on the playground. Teachers will then collect pupils and take them into their classroom closing the doors behind them. As soon as pupils enter the classroom and remove coats and bags, the class register is taken, with pupils in Reception to Year 2 then going straight to Read, Write, Inc and Year 3 – Year 6 starting their first lesson.

If classroom doors are closed, pupils will be expected to enter via the main entrance, with parents signing them in on the electronic entry sign system. This is so we have a record of your child being in school as registers will have been taken in class. Any child entering school after 8:45am will be marked as L (Late before register closes) this will not affect their attendance. If your child enters school after 9:15am they will be marked as U (late after register closes) which could affect their attendance.

If no parent is available, office staff will sign them in.

Blossom Tree Nursery



Within school we have two settings providing early years education to 2 year old and 3 year old children. Blossom Tree Nursery provides education for 2 year olds and places can either be offered free for eligible parents or as a paid place for those not eligible.

Our school nursery offers 15 hours free education for 3 year old children, with eligible parents being offered the opportunity to access 30 hours.
