A huge thank you to all of our parents and pupils for adjusting to the new routines and systems in school in a sensible and supportive way. Although there are still going to be changes we are going to have to make to ensure that our school is COVID safe for our pupils, parents, staff and wider community, the initial steps have worked well to start our term safely.

In the recent survey, which 161 parents returned to school;

- 98% said school were enforcing coronavirus guidelines in an appropriate way
- 99% of parents said their child felt safe in school



So that school can adjust to any need to develop remote learning for short periods of time in case of a localised lockdown, classes from year 3 to 6 are learning how to use Office 365 within school. Activities will be set in class for completion during lessons and for homework so that pupils can get used to the platform and use it as the main method of communication in case pupils have to work from home. Please can we encourage all parents to support their children when using this so you can see how the system works and to ensure that their child/ren are taking part in tasks. Due to the importance of delivering our curriculum in case of a localised lockdown, the use of Office 365 is not optional, and will be the most important way of ensuring pupils can keep up with their school work, engage with a teacher and have assignments marked.
